Please bring the following items to class with you on the first day:

General Supplies to bring to each session:

- Embroidery floss
- Darning or embroidery needles
- Glue stick
- Spray basting
- Black garbage bag or plastic sheet to spray on top of when we spray baste our layers together
- Sharp scissors
- 1 yard piece of flannel for an impromptu design wall
- Batting, your choice, enough for two 24" x 24" pieces
- Backing fabric, two pieces of 24" x 24" fabric you just can't stand to look at anymore in your stash! From 1976...use it up!
- Selection of Fat quarters or Fabric Scraps *no bigger* than a fat quarter.
Please keep in mind the texture- we don't always *have to work with quilters cotton*; silks, batiks, light upholstery fabrics work well too. Don't forget about recycled materials including blouses pants, anything that is pleasing to you.

Day 1 - Elements of Art

Day 2 - Composition through lack of color

- We will be doing two compositions dealing *with just black and white fabrics*. Same size restrictions, no bigger than a fat quarter. Bring what you have I'll bring a lot too.

Day 3 - Color palate constraints and a 15 minute brain break

- Batting and backing for a 10" x 10" composition
