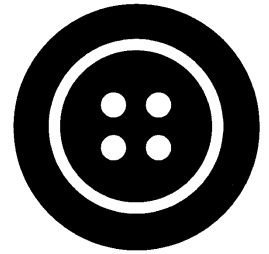

Then use heat to transfer your design on to acrylic fleece and felt. Finish the day by stitching up a scarf or a cute bag, using your dyed fabrics.

THRIFT STORE CHIC AGES 13-16

Monday - Friday Aug 15 - 19, 9 am - 12 pm

Scrounge it, slash it, restyle it in to something fabulous. We will start with a collection of existing garments that need some new life. Spend time in the dye lab overdyeing and adding silkscreened images. You'll learn tips and tricks for working with fitting and altering existing pieces and get inspiration from other creative people. You will need to bring some starting pieces to class with you, supply list provided.

Monday - Friday Aug 15 - 18, 9 am - 12 pm

Make your own beads with gorgeous fabrics and surface design. Sew funky threads on the sewing machine into 3-d shapes. Make shrink plastic pendants with your own artwork. Sculpt wool into flowers and swirly "sushi" beads. Then combine everything with beads to make earrings, necklaces, bracelets and more that you can wear.

Registration Policies & Details

AGES 6 - 16

Please respect the ages listed on the camp description. We have worked closely with the instructors to design these classes so that every student can be successful. To be fair to all students, we need to respect the listed ages.

DROP OFF & PICK UP

We request that you do not drop your child off before 8:45 for morning classes or 12:45 for afternoon classes. We do not have staff available to supervise children before these times.

SUPERVISED LUNCHES

If you are signed up for both a morning and afternoon session, there will be supervision over lunch time. Please bring a lunch and a book to read or something to do.

SNACKS & BREAKS

Students should bring a drink and/or snack with them. We will take a break during class at some point during the morning or afternoon. There is a water fountain available and kids are welcome to put something in the fridge in the kitchen.

PAYMENTS

Payment must be made in full at time of registration. Spaces will not be held without payment.

CONFIRMATIONS

Information packets for all camps will be sent in June 2010. These will include emergency contact forms and other information that you will need to bring to class on your first day.

SUPPLIES & WHAT TO WEAR

For most classes, all of the supplies are included in your registration fees. There are a few special classes that you need to bring some additional materials with you. Please check the supply list **before** the first day of class. Supply lists will be included in your registration packet and are available on our website.

Many classes, especially those held in the dye lab, involve some kind of a mess. Please dress appropriately.

SPECIAL NEEDS

Textile Center is handicapped accessible and all camps are easily adaptable to kids of many ability levels. If your student has any special needs, physical or learning challenges, allergies or other medical concerns, **please** let us know how we can help your student have the best experience possible.

CANCELLATIONS

We occasionally have to cancel a class because we do not have enough students registered. We will make every effort to let you know about any cancellations as soon as possible before the class is scheduled to begin. Please help us by registering early for your camp!

WITHDRAWAL POLICY

If your notice of withdrawal is received more than 1 full working week before the start of your camp, you will receive a full refund of the registration fees minus a \$10 processing fee. If you withdraw less than one week before the start of camp, you will receive a 50% refund of your camp registration fee. If you withdraw less than 1 working day before camp is scheduled to begin, there is no refund. To withdraw from a camp, please call 612.436.0464 during regular business hours.
