

**Supply List - Textile Center Classes & Workshops**

**Class: Down and Dirty Pattern Drafting**

**Date: Feb 13, 20, & 27**

**Please bring the following items with you to class:**

**Additional materials fee, payable to the instructor: \$ 0**

**Three to five yards inexpensive, pre-washed muslin or similar solid fabric for testing patterns. Fabric must be pre-washed and pressed.**

**Large pieces of paper to make patterns---Could be brown wrapping paper, tracing paper, the back of old blueprints--anything that you can write on with a pencil and a pen that isn't too wrinkled or thin or expensive. Your paper must be a solid color or you will go nuts. If you are buying paper special for class, 18" wide tracing paper from an artists supply store works best. Get the canary (yellow gold) color; it costs less, and works as well as white.**

**A C-thru ruler—18" long, 2" across and has a 1/8" grid in red or blue covering the whole surface of the ruler. You can find one at any chain fabric store. Some have a metal edge on one side. The ones without the metal edge seem a bit easier to use, but suit yourself.**

**A good firm tape measure and a yard stick.**

**A right triangle--at least 12"—try your local art supply place.**

**Pens and plain old #2 pencils, a hand sharpener and a big eraser**

**Notebook or note paper—I suggest quad ruled graph paper.**

**Paper scissors**

**Pins, thread, hand needles**

**Tracing wheel and dressmaker's tracing paper**

**Drafting tape, artists tape or plain old masking tape**

**Inexpensive calculator—it only needs to add, sub- tract, multiply and divide**

**Questions, ideas and stories, inspiration, old sewing issues needing solution....**

**Optional, but very nice to have:**

**A 6" wide, 24" long rotary cutting ruler—bring if you have, but don't buy one yet.**

**Also—wear something close-fitting the first night, to ensure accurate measurements**
