Please bring the following items to class with you:

- 3 yards of medium weight muslin, pressed
(Bring 6 yards if working full scale)
- 1/2 scale dress form (preferred)
MySize Barbie also works well
A pattern for covering a MySize Barbie is available from Sandra Ericson's website:

Please Note: You may also work in full scale. Please bring a full scale dress form and appropriate fabric yardage if you choose to work at full scale.)

- pencils
- one black and one red fine tip marker
- eraser
- 12" clear ruler
- yardstick
- French curve
- sharp, 6 -8 inch scissors
- standard sewing kit.
- silk pins -- fine, no glass head.

Lunches:

There will be a lunch break during the day. You are welcome to bring your lunch with you (we have a refrigerator and microwave available) or we will be ordering box lunches for each day of the workshop. Box lunches will be approximately \$8-10 each. We will contact you closer to the Symposium to take orders for lunches.

Parking:

There are several options for parking when you come to the Symposium.

There is a small lot **directly** behind the Textile Center building. Please do not park to the west of the Textile Center building – that lot belongs to our neighbor businesses.

There is a lot to the east of the Textile Center. The Textile Center is at the corner of University and Arthur. Take the alley behind the apartment building on Arthur Ave (right turn). Follow the alley and it will dead end in a parking lot next to a white building. You may park in this lot. (Do not park in the apartment building lots)

There is street parking in the neighborhood behind the Textile Center. The street parking in front of the building has 1 and 2 hour limits and you may get a ticket if you park there for all day.

There is a \$2 surface lot 1 ½ blocks to the northwest of the Textile Center. Take 29th Ave (Next to Overflow Coffee) north for about 1 block. The lot is on your left.
