

## Supply List Summer 2009

Class Title: Intro to Intarsia Knitting

Instructor: Lynn Cooper

Date & Times: Thursday June 11 & 18, 6:00 - 9:00

Please bring the following items to class with you on the first day:

### **100% wool worsted weight yarn—5-8 different colors**

Cascade 220 works beautifully, but raid your stash if possible. You only need a whole skein of one color; the rest can be smaller balls. Be sure that all yarns are very close to the same weight, and that you like this group of colors together.

If you are allergic to wool, please feel free to substitute another fiber. Otherwise, wool is much easier to manage while you are learning any new technique, particularly in the case of intarsia.

### **10 or more bobbins for intarsia**

I use the smaller size of the cheap Susan Bates bobbins. If you want to experiment with another kind, that's fine. Be sure that there is some feature of the bobbin that keeps it from unwinding.

### **A pair of short, straight knitting needles**

After much experimentation, I found that a 9-10" pair of size 7 bamboo needles works extremely well with Cascade 220. Bring a needle size that makes a nice looking swatch with your yarn when you knit in garter stitch. If you have a couple of choices in your collection, bring all candidates.
