Please bring the following items to class with you:

**Basic sewing supplies**

pins, scissors, needles, marking chalk or wax, drafting ruler, measuring tape, etc.

**3 - 5 yards of muslin** or other cheap material that is similar weight to your final fabric

**3-5 yards of a final fabric** you would like to experiment with

Something nice that would make a great finished garment, but not so precious that you would hesitate to cut into it.

**Optional:** Interfacing, buttons or trims that could go with your final fabric.

**A dress form.**

**Your sewing machine in good working order.**

Please remember to bring your power cord, foot pedal, extra bobbins etc.

**Lunches:**

There will be a lunch break during the day. You are welcome to bring your lunch with you (we have a refrigerator and microwave available) or we will be ordering box lunches for each day of the workshop. Box lunches will be approximately \$8-10 each. We will contact you closer to the Symposium to take orders for lunches.

**Parking:**

There are several options for parking when you come to the Symposium.

There is a small lot **directly** behind the Textile Center building. Please do not park to the west of the Textile Center building – that lot belongs to our neighbor businesses.

There is a lot to the east of the Textile Center. The Textile Center is at the corner of University and Arthur. Take the alley behind the apartment building on Arthur Ave (right turn). Follow the alley and it will dead end in a parking lot next to a white building. You may park in this lot. (Do not park in the apartment building lots)

There is street parking in the neighborhood behind the Textile Center. The street parking in front of the building has 1 and 2 hour limits and you may get a ticket if you park there for all day.

There is a \$2 surface lot 1 ½ blocks to the northwest of the Textile Center. Take 29<sup>th</sup> Ave (Next to Overflow Coffee) north for about 1 block. The lot is on your left.
