

Supply List - Textile Center Classes & Workshops

Class: Paint A Skein

Please bring the following items with you to class:

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- 5 skeins of yarn. Choose your favorite weight and style.

Your yarn should be made up of any combination of the following fibers:

wool - superwash is ok.

alpaca

llama

silk

nylon

angora

mohair

soysilk

(These dyes will not work as well on cotton, tencel, bamboo, rayon. "Dye at your own risk." We can't promise what the results will be.)

- 5 - one gallon sized Glad Freezer "ziploc" bags
- box of saran wrap
- Apron or clothes you can get messy in. Gloves.

HOMEWORK:

You will need to make sure your yarn is in hanks or skeins before you come to class. (A hank or skein is a loop of yarn not a ball.) Some yarns come that way already. Use a swift if you have one to make a hank/skein. If you don't have a swift you can use the back of a chair or a friend with 2 free hands.

Put ties around your hank/skein in four places. Think of a clock face at 12, 3, 6 and 9 o'clock. Use plain white/natural cotton yarn to tie it (other colors can transfer their colors to your yarn). Make a "figure eight" with each tie as you tie the strands. These ties will make it much easier to keep your yarn from getting tangled as you dye.

This class has an additional materials fee of \$ 8 , which is payable to the instructor at the first class session.
