Class: Spiral Dress

Please bring the following items with you to class:

2 yards muslin for pattern (could use striped or plaid cotton) or Paper for pattern (if you prefer)

Straight pins

Scissors

Marking pens

Measuring tape

Large plastic ruler 4" x 18"

Needles & thread for hand sewing

Sewing machine & thread

Fabrics for the dress: Look in your stash or Treadle in St. Paul and Ginny's in Rochester has lots available!!

Need 2 yards of 44" wide fabric or 1 1/2 yards 60" wide

Fabrics need to drape well --- silks, lightweight wools (crepes or challis), cotton, blends and even some knits. The fabric needs to be lighter weight and it is helpful if both sides look good against each other.

Thread to match the fabric.

Materials for finishing the neckline and armholes: bias tapes, trims, ribbon, etc.

I will provide some bias trim for the neckline and armholes for \$5 per dress
