

Supply List: Digital Design for Wearable Art

You should bring the following items to class with you:

Your laptop computer in good working condition. Mac or Windows is fine. Be sure to bring your power supply, mouse and any other accessories you think you might need.

A power strip/surge protector style extension cord

A copy of Adobe Photoshop, installed on your computer and ready to use.

You can use any version of Photoshop, CS or newer

(A free trial version can be downloaded at Adobe's website. This version will work fine for class. <http://www.adobe.com/downloads/>)

A self-addressed stamped priority mail envelope. This will be used to mail a finished printed scarf to you after class is over.

Several blank CDs.

\$45 materials fee payable to the instructor. This will cover the cost of printing a finished silk scarf with a design that you create during class.

Optional:

5-10 digital images to use during class. Images should be at least 75 dpi resolution at full size. Photos of bold, colorful objects and patterns will be most useful. Flowers, insects, fish, clouds, walls. Get close-up and farther back images. We will be silhouetting objects, so the background they are on is not too important. Please do not bring copyrighted images.

A CD of images will be provided by the instructor. If you do not have images of your own, you are welcome to use these images as you work during class.

Lunches:

There will be a lunch break during the day. You are welcome to bring your lunch with you (we have a refrigerator and microwave available) or we will be ordering box lunches for each day of the workshop. Box lunches will be approximately \$8-10 each. We will contact you closer to the Symposium to take orders for lunches.

Parking:

There are several options for parking when you come to the Symposium.

There is a small lot **directly** behind the Textile Center building. Please do not park to the west of the Textile Center building – that lot belongs to our neighbor businesses.

There is a lot to the east of the Textile Center. The Textile Center is at the corner of University and Arthur. Take the alley behind the apartment building on Arthur Ave (right turn). Follow the alley and it will dead end in a parking lot next to a white building. You may park in this lot. (Do not park in the apartment building lots)

There is street parking in the neighborhood behind the Textile Center. The street parking in front of the building has 1 and 2 hour limits and you may get a ticket if you park there for all day.

There is a \$2 surface lot 1 ½ blocks to the northwest of the Textile Center. Take 29th Ave (Next to Overflow Coffee) north for about 1 block. The lot is on your left.
