- Kitchen type plastic gloves
- 2-3 towels
- 2 kitchen type sponges (without scrubbie sides)
- sharp scissors (a pair of manicure scissors are also helpful)
- plastic bag to take samples home
- measuring tape and sharpie pen
- Notebook and pen
- package of 50 glass marbles, or beans and/or small stones
- various clamps like bulldog clamps found at office max type stores - lg, med, small sizes
- wooden spring type clothes pins

There is a \$35 materials fee for this class, payable at the first class session.
