Workshop will be provided with Indigo Dye Vat

Student supplies: Students can bring -

Fabric pieces: washed cotton, light to medium weight; and /or medium and heavy silk (totaling 2 to 3 yards.)

Ruler or tape measure.

Scissors

Rubber gloves, apron

String, cord, rope for tying

Needles -long with an eye for strong threads in cotton, poly, in different colors.

Masking tape.

Plastic bags (grocery/ produce).

Journal or notebook

Fugitive ink pen or soft lead pencil for marking

C-clamp or medium grip clamp

Small piece of card board such as the backing from a paper pad, coin (a quarter)

Seam ripper

Small long piece of Tyvek type of strong water-resistant material (FedEx or USPS mail bag)

Optional:

plastic bottle caps, buttons, and other small objects to insert.

old newspapers

plastic (PVC) pipe, 4-10 inches in diameter and approx. 3 feet in length.
